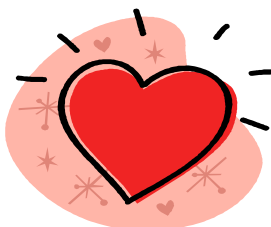

Financial Aid Applications
