Hello Parents,

We are very grateful for your patience and support as we build our online program. Please see important information and instructions below.

- Each student will need her/his own device. (have a post-it or piece of tape ready to cover the camera)
- Your child may use a computer/laptop, tablet, ipad or phone.
- We will be using Google Meet for interactive lessons (homeroom, math, science) A link will be sent through email to allow the student to join the Meet/lesson. Kinder -Fifth will use student Gmail addresses, Pre-school, Pre-k and Jr. K will use parent email addresses. Kinder - Fifth Gmail login credentials will be sent home on Tuesday.
- Google Meet lessons will be recorded for students unable to participate in the live lesson. A link will be emailed to access the recorded lesson.
- We will use YouTube for pre-recorded lessons (art, music, French, computer, sports). Students may access these lessons at any time.
- If using a computer, you will need the Google Chrome browser.
- If using a phone, tablet or ipad you will need the Google Meet app.
- The student device should have a camera and microphone so your child may ask questions and share work. But if the device does not have a camera or microphone, your child can still see and hear the lesson.
- Students will be asked to turn in completed work by sharing in google drive or email.
